PLAN AHEAD!

Kishwaukee Archers is the host club for the tournament this year so there is lots of extra work to be done and the need for lots of help August 14th and 15th during the shoot.

As of today, there are 137 shooters who have qualified with two qualifications to go so maybe 150 qualified. not all will end up shooting and the number per day will depend on how many are in each class on the assigned. day. MAC said to figure at least 100 shooters and the number per day will depend on the number in the classes that day. Also, there are 17 youth shooters and they will be accompanied by an adult as well as other companions.

MAC will have 8-10 board members to handle check in, preordered shirts, bow and arrow checks, announcements and awards each day counting score cards.

Tony will have his 25 ft cooking trailer there so he will need help each day.

Randy and Jim have offered the use of their ATV's, so we made need some drivers also. it May be that we could use another ATV .we will need 4 range captains to cover 7/8 targets on the course to handle question, get help for equipment failures, scoring issues and keep the groups moving on a timely schedule. Two of the atv's will roam the course as needed. And fill water stations particularly if it is very hot.

parking will be at a premium with a lot of it on Lukens and Buzzell roads.so help will be needed there we will try to have shirts for the Kish staff but if not, then orange hunting vests should work. Porta-potties and cleaning station have been ordered. the grass and paths will be cut but
