Check your target points and inserts to make sure they are tight and don't come out in the target. You cannot dig them out with a knife or anything else that will damage the target bales.

The bales are expensive, and we must rent a lift to install them. The damaged bales affect all of us, cuts down on available lanes for shooting in general, for the leagues and any tournaments., this is OUR club, Yours and mine so let's do everything we can to keep it in good shape and looking good.

It's time to start thinking about this season's **Indoor Paper League.** We had a great turnout last year, and everyone had a lot of fun. I hope to have at least the same amount of participation this, and hopefully more. I am going to include a brief description of how the league will work. Here is a basic description:

Indoor Paper league will run for about 10 - 12 weeks, starting in early January. All ages and shooting styles/equipment are welcome. We will be using a handicap system to make sure that archers are competing fairly. The first few weeks of the league will be submitting scores to establish your handicap. The rest of the league will be head to head matches, again adjusted by handicap. The winner of each match earns a point, and the archer with the most points at the end wins. There will be cash prizes for the top shooters, as well as some fun prizes for archers at all levels. You will need to turn in one score per week to determine the winner of your match. We will not all be shooting on one night at the same time. You can shoot a score any day of the week, as long as it is submitted before Sunday. Mondays will be our "official" day, so if anyone does want to shoot together, Monday evening would be the time. Cost would be something like 50 dollars for members, but that might change slightly. Nonmembers are welcome to join the league, but their cost would be a little higher and they would need to shoot with a member.

Please feel free to reach out with any questions that you have, and I will be happy to answer them! I know not everyone is very experienced in these kinds of leagues, so don't hesitate to ask!
