# Kishwaukee work hour projects. Use log splitter to split wood for fireplace.



NOTE: For club insurance reasons!

When using any power equipment (like chain saw or log splitter) there must be at least TWO people for safety.

The club log splitter has been chained up so it can be moved out and used. There will be a pile of wood that needs to be split and stored for club use.
