Indoor 360 League



Kishwaukee Archers will be hosting an indoor 360 paper league this season.

Archers will use the NFAA 5 spot target. We will be using a 360 scoring system, meaning the X is counted as 6, the rest of the white as 5, the blue rings as 4. A single spot target may also be used to score the same way, only including the rest of the rings for scoring. One round will consist of 12 ends of 5 arrows, totaling 60 arrows.

All ages and archery styles are welcome (compound, recurve, barebow, youth, etc.). We will be using the official NFAA handicap system which will be updated weekly. Along with the 360 scoring format, this should make matches as even and fair as possible.

The league will run for 10 weeks, starting the week of January 10 and ending the week of March 14. Any shoot offs, prizes and awards will be on March 21.

Archers need to submit one score per week, shot any day or time that works for you. I am hoping to have anyone interested come and shoot on Monday evenings at 7 pm to try to keep the fun of shooting in a group. However, if you can't make it or prefer to shoot at another time, that is totally fine. Scores and targets need to be submitted by Sunday evening to count for the week.

Cost of the league is \$50 for members, which includes targets, possible prizes, and supporting the club. Non-members are welcome to sign up, but their cost will be \$65 and they will need to shoot on Mondays or shoot with a member. Cash prizes will be awarded to winning shooters, along with additional prizes for a variety of other categories.

Sign-up information below! Please consider joining even if you don't think of yourself as a competitive shooter. Support your club, have some fun, and challenge yourself. This is a great way to get some shooting in, track your progress, and practice under a little pressure.
